After nearly 100 years of operating from a pushcart along Swatow Lane and 10 more spent at a food court, the famous Swatow Lane Ais Kacang (formerly Lee Brothers' Ais Kacang) has set-up shop on a larger scale at New World Park. Currently managed by the fourth-generation owners Lee Wah Kooi and Lee Wah Chai, Swatow Lane's Ais Kacang is steeped in history and a part of Penang's rich heritage. - Penang Laksa, another Penang favourite, can also be found at their stall. Penang Laksa typically consists of thick wheat noodles or rice vermicelli with shredded fish, and finely sliced vegetables including cucumber, onions, red chillies, pineapple, lettuce and mint, served in spicy soup based on sour assam (tamarind) and topped with a thick sweet prawn-shrimp paste. • Make your own Tau Sar Pheah: One of the famous local cake in Penang is Tau Sar Pheah. You will have chance to make your own Tau Sar Pheah.
